

Dana and I have made a banner displaying the club name and CC logo for our personal use. The banner was displayed at Long Beach and Mardi Gras North in Fairview OR. Members in attendance asked about getting one made for them as well. We have modified the design slightly to make it possible to produce banners for individual members at a reasonable cost. The member design has been approved by NWCCers Board of Directors for sale to the members of NWCCers. The NWCCers Board also purchased a duplicate of our original design for club use with silk-screened logos instead of the sewn appliques used in our original design.

The member banner will be hand made by Dana and me. The color panel arrangement will be the same on all banners, but the red, blue and green colors will be in different positions on each banner with the CC logo and NWCCers logo silk-screened onto the white panels in a weather-resistant process similar to those shown in the pictures above right (the color order is random, you will not have a choice of color order). The banner will be 8' by 2' hand delivered with a two-part banner pole (PVC pipe) and stake (1/2 inch rebar) so it can be displayed, all in its own storage bag. Setup takes just a minute or two to drive the stake into the ground with a hammer. Total storage length is about 5'. We cannot ship the banners with a pole, however. If you cannot pick up your banner at a chapter rally and want it mailed to you, the price will remain the same, but it will not come with a pole or stake. The price will remain the same to cover shipping and handling and will come with very simple instruction on how to make a pole to display your banner. Commercial poles are also available from a variety of sources.

This will be a limited run of 12 banners. Once these are gone, Dana and I will assess whether we want to offer more in the future. We will hand deliver banners, poles and stakes at the Hoodspport Rally and the rest at the FMCA NW Area Pre-Rally event in June. The banners are priced at \$35 each, which covers the material costs and includes a PVC pole and stake. Banners shipped to you will not include a pole or stake.



Now that it's Summer, you're probably planning your adventures for the coming RV season. We hope you'll include the Sept. 19-23 rally at Casey's Riverside RV Park in Westfir, Oregon. Casey's is located about 40 miles southeast of Eugene, Oregon, on Highway 58. It is on the banks of the north fork of the Willamette River. We have reserved 15 pull-through sites on the waterfront...first come, first served. There are additional sites available that are not on the waterfront, but nearby. Sites reserved for our group are facing toward the river..

We have stayed at the park several times and it is so relaxing to enjoy the sound of the river running just 150' or so past the front of your coach. It is a very restful setting.

Kayakers and drift boats go down river. Grounds are beautifully maintained and there's a great clubhouse for our use, which has a large fireplace, large screen TV, fully-equipped kitchen, and lots of games and puzzles for our enjoyment. There is also a covered open-air pavilion with picnic tables and propane heaters, and a soft ice cream machine (\$1 for a cone or dish).

Nearby are waterfalls, covered bridges, hiking and biking trails, beautiful Odell Lake, a fish hatchery, and just 31 miles away is a ski lift at Willamette Pass. During the non-ski season, gondolas are used for rides to the top where there is a spectacular view. Geocachers can seek out several caches hidden in the Westfir/Oakridge area. Or, just pull out a lawn chair and



watch and listen to the beautiful Willamette River rush by.

This will be a relaxing rally and will NOT be filled with scheduled activities, but, rather, will be a chance to get together in a beautiful setting and enjoy each other's company.

One evening, we will have a potluck dinner and gather in the clubhouse or the pavilion for "happy hour" with light snacks each late afternoon. The Wagon Masters will do a biscuits and gravy breakfast on Saturday. September is

always a beautiful month in the Pacific Northwest and we hope you'll make your plans to join us.

The nightly rate is \$37.28, including tax, but if you want to stay longer, the weekly rate is \$234.35, including tax. When you **call Casey's at (541-782-1906) to make your reservation**, tell them you are with the NW Country Coach group and provide a credit card and a \$35 deposit to hold the reservation.

There will be a \$10 rally fee per coach.

NORTHWEST COUNTRY COACHERS KITCHEN

DUMP CAKE

Preheat oven to 350
Spray a 13 x 9 with Pam
Two 15-oz. cans of Cherries (not filling), one can with juice, the other drained
One 20-oz can of Crushed Pineapple with juice
One Yellow Cake Mix
3/4 cup Melted Butter
1 cup Chopped Pecans

Mix the cherries and pineapple in a bowl until combined. Pour into prepared 13 x 9 pan. Sprinkle DRY cake mix over the fruit. Pour the melted butter over the dry cake mix. Sprinkle nuts on top. Bake 50 minutes. Great with whipped or ice cream.



MEXICAN CASSEROLE (WITH CHICKEN)

Preheat oven to 350.
2 Tbsp oil
3/4 lb Cubed Chicken (breasts or thighs)
1 pkg. Taco Seasoning
One 15-oz can Black or Red Beans (drained)
1 can of drained corn (I use about a cup of frozen)
1/2 cup Salsa
1 cup shredded Cheddar or Mexican Blend Cheese
1-1/2 cup crushed Tortilla Chips

Sauté the chicken and add taco seasoning, beans, corn, salsa and a little water to prevent drying out. We also like to add a can of sliced olives at this point; peppers would also work if you like it spicy. Transfer the chicken mixture to a baking dish and top with half of the cheese and the tortilla chips. Bake for 15 minutes. Add the rest of the cheese until melted.


Note: This makes a good size meal, so I only bake half of it at a time. Freezing half and adding the chips later makes the topping better.

Guadalupe River RV Resort Earns TACO Award

The park, which borders the Guadalupe River, has 212 RV sites, including pull-through sites with 30- and 50-amp service as well as wireless Internet and cable television service. It also has 46 park models, 17 cabins, three swimming pools, including an indoor heated pool during

Ever since Don Temple and a group of investors purchased Guadalupe River RV Resort in Kerrville, Texas, seven years ago, they have constantly worked to improve park, investing more than \$1 million in improvements.

And, according to a press release, their efforts are clearly paying off.

Last week, the riverfront resort won the “Park of the Year” award in the large park category from the Texas Association of Campground Owners (TACO) for the third year in a row. Guadalupe River RV Resort has also won top ratings from the nation’s leading campground directories, including 5W ratings from Woodall’s North American Campground Directory and 9.5/9/9 ratings from Trailer Life.

the winter, a hot tub, a dry heat sauna, a steam sauna, exercise room, laundry rooms and two large recreation halls, plus an attractive onsite bar with indoor and outdoor seating.

“We’re still the only RV park in Texas with a liquor license,” Temple said, adding that the onsite bar is a popular amenity for RVers who like to enjoy their drinks without having to worry about getting back on the road. Temple also has barbecues on weekends, which are always well attended.

But while the improvements and amenities and fine customer service ensure repeat business for his park, Temple said the ratings and awards help put Guadalupe River RV Resort on the map. “People pay attention to ratings,” he said.

Did you know?

Most coach owners have experienced the dreaded "White Streaks" running down the sides of their coaches. The streaks are unsightly and can be difficult to clean off. They are caused by oxidation of the gel coat on the coach roof and moisture causes the oxidation to run off the roof and down the sides. The traditional fix has been to wax the roof or to apply 303 Aerospace Protectant as recommended by CC in the past. The problem with these products is that they break down when exposed to UV sunlight and require frequent reapplications to ensure protection.

A product called RejeX has been developed for the marine industry to protect fiberglass surfaces in aggressive saltwater environments and it works well on coach roofs too. When properly applied, it can provide roof protection for at least six months and up to a year in some areas. It seals glass, metal, plastic and painted surfaces—stuff does not stick to it! RejeX also works well on the front of the coach and reduces the effort required for the daily chore of cleaning bugs and road grime off the windshield and coach front after traveling. Due to the aggressive environment and multiple washings on the coach front, several applications annually are recommended for this application.

RejeX is available through marine supply stores and online.
