



For years we complained about the jack-knife sofa in our 2007 Inspire, how uncomfortable it is, and how useless it is as a place to sleep. We hardly ever sat on it, and instead we used it as a place to keep books, jackets, or anything else needing short-term storage.

In April, after leaving the coach at Oregon Motor Coach for its annual servicing, we decided to stop at Countryside Interiors in Junction City. We were amazed with the choices of replacement furniture. With the help of the owner, Steven Skiller, we chose a sofa with recliners on both ends that matched the upholstery on our captain chairs. The seats will go to almost full recline without the backrest hitting the wall of our coach. The middle back section of the sofa folds down to become an arm rest, which has a phone charger and three USB ports for charging. In the middle of the bottom, there is a large drawer suitable for holding remotes, charging cords, or other items. The sofa is electrically controlled, easy to use, and so comfortable.



The sofa had to be ordered. It arrived on a Friday, two days before we were leaving for a 10-day trip, but Steven arranged for us to come in on Saturday to have it installed, which only took a couple hours to do.


